


# Daily Devotions for the New Year

# Today's Featured Devotion – When You Pray: Daily Practices for Prayerful Living



When You Pray is a daily prayer guide offering a full year of readings and scripture and is an excellent tool to use in daily prayer time. Each weekly segment includes daily scripture readings, prayer, offering of self and blessing, a brief essay from the author, and collection of quotes from well-known voices in spiritual formation, along with additional material and prayers.

While it is a more traditional resource which comes only in book form, it is an excellent guide to keep with your Bible. You can easily adapt the materials to your own needs and style. The resource "seeks to respond to the needs we all have for a pattern of prayer that is accessible, usable and adaptable to our diverse life experiences in our contemporary world. It seeks to follow the pattern of prayer that Jesus taught the disciples and in his own prayers recorded in the Gospels.

When You Pray was written by Reuben P. Job, a retired United Methodist bishop, noted spiritual formation teacher and former World Editor of The Upper Room publishing program.


